Ronald H. White, is an Oklahoma City resident, and was appointed to the State Regents in May 2003 by Governor Brad Henry.

He has also served as medical director for the Oklahoma Heart Center and medical staff president for Integris Baptist Medical Center.

He has served as a member of the University of Oklahoma Board of Regents for 14 years and as a member of the board of directors for Oklahoma Gas and Electric since 1989. He has also been a member of the Board of Commissions for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigations.
